2010 SUMMARIZED BUSINESS REVIEW

The Board is pleased to present a summarized business review of 2010 of the Company and its subsidiaries (together the “Group”) to the shareholders of the Company.

- In 2010, the Group attained 13 wind power project approvals (total capacity of 900MW) from National/Provincial Development and Reform Commission.
- The Group had 9 new wind farms started operation in 2010. The total capacity is 597MW (attributable capacity of 374MW). As at 31 December 2010, the Group has a total of 21 operational wind farms with total capacity of 1,163MW (attributable capacity of 657MW). Compare to 2009 year end, the Group’s wind farm capacity has increased by more than a double.
- In 2010, the Group generated total electricity of 1,125.88 million kwh in total, representing an increase of 194% compared to 2009. The attributable portion was 510.83 million kwh, representing an increase of 217% compared to 2009.
- The Group has also secured CDM registration with the United Nations for 5 projects. A total of 7 projects are now registered for CDM.

- In 2010, the Group's wind power plants reduced emission of carbon dioxide by 1.15 million tons, the emission of sulfur dioxide by 11,444 tons, and the emission of nitrogen oxides by 1,015 tons. In contrast to coal-fired thermal power plant, the Group's wind power plants saved standard coal of 390,000 tons and water of 3.24 million tons for the country.
